The Greens	<p>The Greens New South Wales is the political party at the state level of the Greens party (national). The Greens NSW have four members in the New South Wales Legislative Council (Parliament). The fundamental objectives of The Greens NSW are to promote social, economic and political change in accordance with the four principles of:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ecological sustainability; 2. Social equality and economic justice; 3. Grassroots democracy; and 4. Peace, disarmament and nonviolence.
Australian Institute of International Affairs (AIIA)	<p>AIIA is an independent, non-profit organisation seeking to promote interest in and understanding of international affairs in Australia. It provides a forum for discussion and debate, but does not seek to formulate its own institutional views. The Institute arranges programs of lectures, seminars, workshops, conferences and other discussions, and sponsors research and publications. The AIIA was formed in 1924 and established as a federal body in 1933 and is the only nation-wide organisation of its kind in Australia.</p>
Mr Greg Smith, Minister of Parliament (MP) - NSW Parliament Legislative Assembly	<p>Mr Smith is a member of the NSW Legislative Assembly (State Parliament) and the Liberal Party. Mr Smith is the local member for the area of Epping (meaning this is where he was elected to represent). Within Parliament (as a member for the opposition) he has also been given the roles of Shadow Attorney General, Shadow Minister for Justice and Shadow Minister for Juvenile Justice</p>
Ethnic Communities Council	<p>The Ethnic Communities' Council of NSW (ECC) is a non-government peak body representing many organizations and people from the multicultural community in NSW. The ECC of NSW's primary roles are advocacy, education and community development. The ECC of NSW actively promotes the principles of multiculturalism, and lobbies for the development of culturally inclusive society. The Council is involved in developing strategies regarding the most important issues to touch ethnic communities, including Environmental policy.</p>
